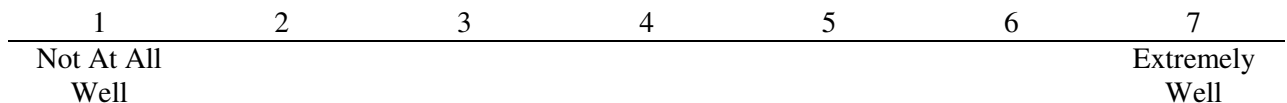

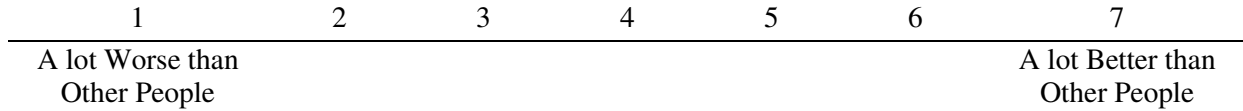

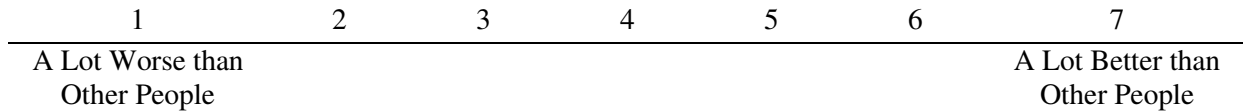

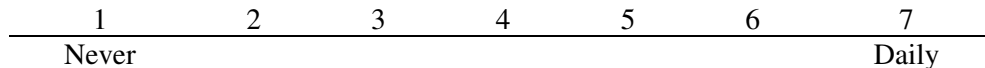
Teaching and explaining to others?

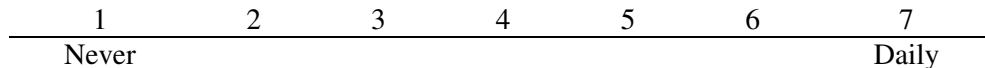

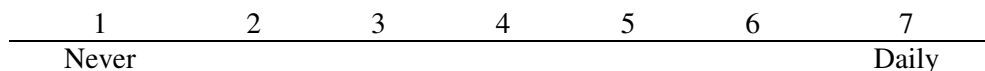
